#### TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP- HORSES

1. Membership is open to all horses of Endurance status (Yellow Logbook) whose owner/agent is not under suspension.
1. b) Owners/Agents of horses subject to this application are not required to be members of the AES, however, Owners or their Agents must be Divisional members of the AERA and as such will be subject to the AES Code of Conduct.
2. Only financial horses will be eligible for selection at World Championships and World Equestrian Games, or any other international event where Australian Teams are represented
3. Horses must be financial Squad members for a period of 12 months before they can be considered for selection to WC'S (this may vary from time to time depending on the dates of WC's)
4. Only Squad horses will be eligible to represent Australia at Continental Championships (Pan Am and Euro) and Trans Tasman competitions.
5. The owner/agent of Squad horses must supply information to the coach/manager on request and on time.
6. All Logbook results and vets comments must be forwarded to the coach/manager within the week following any competition entered.
7. Owner/agents of Squad horses will be required to sign a code of conduct and agreement.
8. On acceptance as a Squad horse, the owner/agent will be notified of its current Achievement level and be provided with details of the requirements for all Achievement Levels.

## **AES Code of Conduct**

1. *As a member of A Division of the AERA, you will be required to conduct yourself in a professional manner at all times. This will include*
  - a) *Setting a good example in dress and presentation of yourself and your horse/s and associated equipment*
  - b) *Behaving professionally and accepting responsibility for your actions.*
  - c) *Conducting yourself in a professional manner relating to Language, temper, punctuality and truthfulness.*
  - d) *respecting the rights, dignity and worth of fellow squad members*
2. *Refrain from any behaviour that may bring the AES, AERA and EA and any of the members, associates or affiliated clubs into disrepute, this includes interacting with fellow squad members in a dignified and respectful manner and refraining from making statements, publicly or electronically that may be construed as defamatory.*
3. *Horses accepted for membership to the Squad shall remain drug free at all times during competition as per AERA Rule P 1 (Prohibited Substances Rules, AERA Members Handbook 2008)*
