Where: Mt Binga State Forest (Ride base Mt Binga Lutheran Camp grounds)

Mt Binga Forest is in the middle of the Yarraman, Cooyar, Blackbutt area. Easy access is from Blackbutt or Cooyar .Directions Below

Planned rides :-

20km Sat afternoon. Start time 3 pm Single leg

20 km Sun morning. Start time 5am. Single leg

40 km Sun morning. Start time 4:30am . Single leg

All Nominations commencing 11am Saturday

Pre ride Vetting 12noon-4pm Saturday

Pre ride talk 2pm Saturday for 20km

Presentation Saturday night 7.30pm for Saturday 20km

Followed by pre ride talk for Sunday 20 & 40 km

Presentation for Sunday 20 & 40km at 10am.

Showers and toilets are available.

Bore water available for horses,

People drinking water to be brought by each entrant.

There is no catering for the weekend, but we will probably offer a sausage sizzle and cold drinks on Saturday night .

Vets will be available for ID & microchip during the weekend by private arrangement, pay on the day.

Riders to supply microchips .

Get your horse ID'd for the coming season.

Ride costs will be \$20 and \$40 + amenities fee of \$10 + day membership \$15 as required.

Our QERA Registrar Colleen Shaw will be available for any late memberships.

Limited accommodation is available at \$10 per bed per night. BYO bedding. Bookings required.

Camping ground area is kindly provided Mt Binga Lutheran Outdoor Education Centre.

All rides will be through Mt Binga State Forest and plantations, footing will be a bit of everything, mostly forest tracks consisting of soft and leafy, some rocky parts, a little mud if we get rain ,some firm surfaces. Some areas are tough underfoot.

Terrain along the central forestry road is flat to slight inclines, there are good climbs either side .Logging trucks use most of these roads throughout the year so steady climbs, and steep stuff. The ride offers challenging climbs. Mt Binga is a beautiful riding area, picturesque and cool riding in forestry.

Directions:

From Crows Nest (New England Hwy)turn at the pub either left from Cooyar side or right from Toowoomba side onto Emu Creek Rd. Follow for 36km travelling north, up the range, then left onto Cooyar Mt Binga Rd, then first left again to enter the Lutheran Camp grounds. The 36km comprises both dirt and bitumen roads

From Blackbutt turn at the pub onto Hart St, follow signs for Crows Nest. 22km from the pub turn right onto Cooyar Mt Binga Rd, then left into the Lutheran camp grounds. The 22km comprises of mainly bitumen with some dirt road..

From Yarraman go 10.7km on D'Aguliar Highway then turn right on Nukku Crows Nest Rd. Stay on that road for 18.6km, The camp entrance is on the corner of Mt Binga , Blackbutt,Cooyar Rd.

From Cooyar turn right at the pub coming from south and left at the pub coming from Yarraman side, travel that road, some bitumen and some gravel for about 19km . The Lutheran camp will be on your right.
