INFORMATION SHEET

RESPONSIBILITY OF RIDING MEMBERS AT RIDES

1. Have your membership card with you – No card, no ride.
2. Have your horse's logbook with you – No logbook, no entry into endurance rides.
3. Keep children under supervision at all times so they too respect the rights of other members. Bicycles are to be kept away from horses at any time.
4. All dogs to be kept under control and on a leash AT ALL TIMES.
5. Make sure your yards are adequate so that your horses are CONFINED at all times.
6. Other members are camped nearby. They may like peace and quiet so noise should be kept to a minimum at all times.
7. Horses must be ridden around the camp in a way which does not cause danger to others nor cause horses to break out of their yards. Galloping around the camp area is never acceptable.
8. The Ride Secretary has a full time job with the paper work and does not have time to be distracted. If you have any questions or complaints of any sort please direct these to the Chief Steward as it is their job to deal with such matters.
9. At every ride there are VERA Committee Members who are available to assist any member needing help. Please do not hesitate to speak to these Members if you are unsure of anything.
10. If you are unhappy with any aspect of the ride, see the Chief Steward.
11. If your horse is vetted out and you are unhappy with the decision, DO NOT DISTRACT THE VET AND OTHER RIDERS AT THAT TIME. Please note the following:
 - a. Your horse must not leave the vetting area nor can it be left there unattended.
 - b. Approach the Chief Steward about your concern.
12. At all times remember not to be abusive or loud as this can lead to suspension
