

Ownership of the Endurance Horse

TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP FORM

It is the responsibility of the purchaser of the Endurance horse to notify their State Endurance Organisation of the change of ownership details. It is important that the correct person be registered as the owner of the horse to assist in the allocation of National and State distance and point-score awards as well as identifying the persons responsible for the horse when disciplinary actions need to be instituted.

Process for Changing Ownership Details.

When the sale of a horse with an AERA logbook issued occurs, it is the **responsibility of the new owner** to notify their State Endurance Organisation of the change of ownership. A transfer of ownership form must be completed and forwarded to the logbook registrar, together with the full fee and the logbook.
