EQUINE MEDICATION LOG FOR HORSES COMPETING AT AERA RIDES

Only to be completed if your horse has been administered any prohibited substances in the 28 days prior to the competition

This Equine Medication Log is to serve as a record of each and every medication, listed on the FEI list of Prohibited Substances, which was given to the horse within the 28 days prior to the ride in which the horse has entered. Each medication administered must be recorded on the Log including the name of both the handler and the person administering the medication. The completion of this Log is a compulsory requirement for all horses entering AERA affiliated rides.

The Person Responsible shall provide 2 copies of this form to the head veterinarian prior to the commencement of the pre-ride veterinary inspection for the horse. The Person Responsible shall retain 1 copy signed by the head veterinarian for their records. The head veterinarian shall pass the 2nd signed copy to the chief steward.
